There are about 50 kits to choose from including new panels, premade tops that just need quilting and binding, some quick strippies which require sewing some strips together and simple quilting and we also have long arm compatible quilts available for pick up or delivery. You ladies never cease to amaze me with how beautiful these quilts are!

Monday -- "Fun and Games in Quilting" lecture. It's game on for this playful twist on quilting!

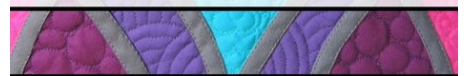
Tuesday -- "Free Motion Crea-TV and Reality" as Mel shares her love of free motion quilting as it relates to her guilty pleasure of watching reality television!

She had so much fun playing around with classic quilt blocks and puzzling out how to use pre-cuts to make them!

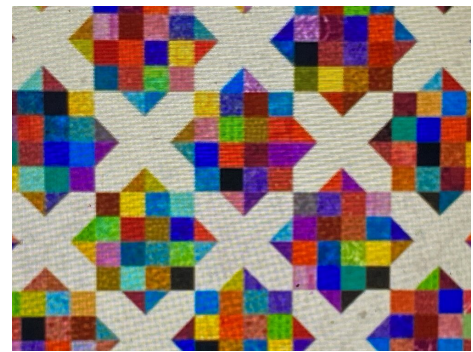

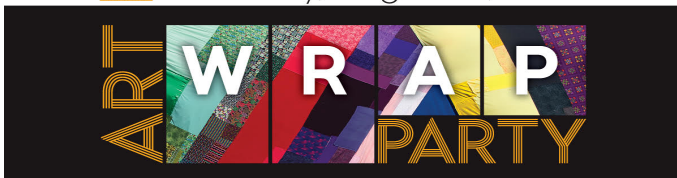

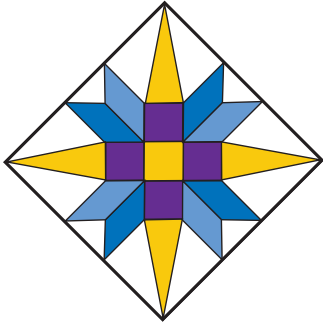
