

# Wool Embroidery Ornaments

## Choose the Size

Trace two identical circles of the finished size ornament that you would like to make. You can use a cookie cutter, cup or bowl if you like.

## Transfer

Transfer your stitched designs to the wool piece. You can lightly sketch the drawing with pencil or chalk. If your pattern is more intricate, Glad Cling Wrap can be used to trace the paper design with a permanent marker. Move Cling Wrap to the wool ornament and adhere it to the wool.

## Using Additional Wool Colors

If you are using contrasting colored wool pieces, trace these shapes onto freezer paper, cut out and iron onto the contrasting wool. Cut out these shapes.

## Embroider

Use various embroidery stitches to decorate the wool ornament. Use any type of thread that is pleasing to you.

If using additional wool pieces, add them to the design with a blanket or whipstitch.

Add beading if desired.

## Finishing

Place finished ornament pieces Wrong Sides Together and begin to blanket stitch the two pieces to each other. Before you stitch all the way around the circle, add pillow stuffing to the center and then complete the blanket stitching. Add a loop of thread or ribbon as a hanger for your ornament.
