## A Dozen Donuts? YUM! Quilt <br> Finished Size 36 " x 48 "

Use ONE yard of TWO contrasting colors to create this delightful quilt top for Shriners. Requires 36 " $\times 48^{\prime \prime}$ batting. 1.5 yards backing,

- Cut SEVEN 4.5" Strips width of fabric of each color.
- Use 4 of each color strips cut TWELVE 4.5" x 12.5" Rectangles from each color (3 per strip)
- Use the remaining 3 strips to make ONE Light/Dark/Light and ONE Dark/Light/Dark strip set. Press seams to the darker fabric.
- Subcut each strip set to SIX $4.5 " \times 12.5$ " Rectangles.
- Sew a 12.5 " rectangle to each side of the strip set; matching colors to create the "donut". Press seams away from the center .
- You'll have 6 of each color donut each is 12.5 " square. If needed, trim each block square.
- Piece each horizontal row as shown. Press seams towards the 4.5 " x 12.5 " rectangle.
- Sew Rows together as shown. Pressing seams towards the $4.5^{\prime \prime} \times 12.5^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle.
- Use remaining fabric to create 6 yards of scrappy binding ( 2.25 " wide)
- Sandwich, Quilt and Bind
