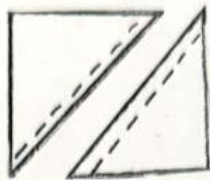
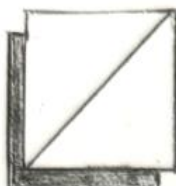


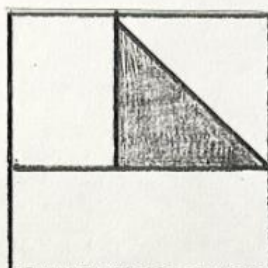
Prairie Star Quilt Guild

Quick and Easy Block - Scrappy or Not

1. Cut 3 1/2" squares of a background fabric and a contrasting fabric. Draw a line on the back of one of the fabrics diagonally from corner to corner.
2. Sew 1/4" on either side of the drawn line then cut on the drawn line to produce two half square triangles (HST). Press each HST to the darker side then trim to 3".



3. Cut one piece of background fabric 2" x 3" and another piece 2" x 4 1/2". Watching the orientation of the HST, attach the 2" x 3" piece. Press away from the HST. Attach the 2" x 4 1/2" piece as shown. Press toward the new piece. The block should measure 4 1/2" square.



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
